Ilima activity (R85 pp, minimum 10 persons, 1.5 hours)

In the Xhosa and various other cultures, Ilima is an important community-based initiative that happens in the villages when someone needs help in their home.

This calling on community members to come together and help each other, builds on the values of Ubuntu. Morning gathering and work at the SI has always been about bringing the wider community of learners, visitors and staff together, and giving back meaningfully to the space.
